


Point

2. There is only one true God

For although there may be so-called gods in heaven or on earth—as indeed there are many “gods” and many “lords”— yet for us there is one God, the Father, from whom are all things and for whom we exist, and one Lord, Jesus Christ, through whom are all things and through whom we exist.” (1 Corinthians 8:5–6, ESV)

The ankh sign dates back to the First Dynasty (c. 30th to 29th century BC). its origins are rooted in a **polytheistic (many gods)**, Egyptian non-Christian belief system. symbolizes life, the sun, or a womb

Point

3. All paths don't lead to the same God, some lead to destruction

"Enter by the narrow gate. For the gate is wide and the way is easy that leads to destruction, and those who enter by it are many. For the gate is narrow and the way is hard that leads to life, and those who find it are few." (Matthew 7:13–14, ESV)

Point

Jesus said to him, "I am the way, and the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me." (John 14:6, ESV)

Wrap it up

And if it is **evil in your eyes** to serve the Lord, **choose** this day whom you will serve, whether **the gods your fathers served** in the region beyond the River, or the **gods of the Amorites** in whose **land you dwell**. But as for me and my house, we will serve the Lord.” (Joshua 24:15, ESV)
