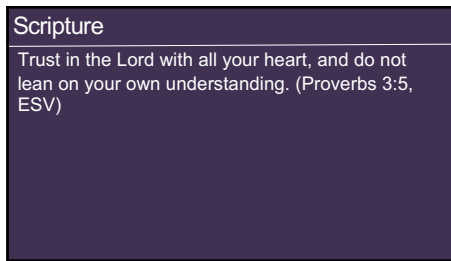

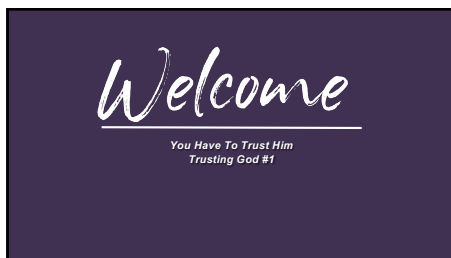

**Point**

2. Trust Him during the storm  
 The Lord is good, a refuge in times of trouble. He cares for those who **trust** in him," (Nahum 1:7, NIV84)  
 The Lord is good, a stronghold in the day of trouble; he knows those who take **refuge** in him." (Nahum 1:7, ESV)  
 Key: Not afraid of a storm, but seeks protection during the storm

**Point**

 purpose,' (Isaiah 46:9–10, ESV)

**Wrap it up**
